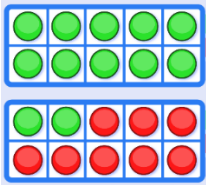


Year 1 home learning opportunities in the event of school closure-

Maths- addition and subtraction to 20

We have recently been working on adding and subtracting to 20 using tens frames. Children can practise writing all 4 number sentences to help understand inverse, e.g.



$$12 + 8 = 20 \quad 8 + 12 = 20$$

$$20 - 12 = 8 \quad 20 - 8 = 12$$
