Addendum to Behaviour Policy

This addendum to the Behaviour Policy is for use for all pupils on their full return to school in September 2020. It is to be read alongside the Behaviour Policy, Anti-bullying Policy, Peer on Peer Abuse Policy and Physical Intervention Policy. This policy has been created to ensure the safety of all, following the guidance from the department for education:-

Referring to our current Behaviour Policy, the children will be taught the expectations for behaviour whilst on the school site.

Positive Praise

Children will receive stickers/smileys from adults within their bubble to recognise positive behaviour. Teachers will move children's names up the charts rather than children moving their own names.

As we are not permitted to gather together in large numbers, celebration assemblies will not be held this half-term. Children who earn certificates will be presented with these in class assemblies.

Procedures for unacceptable behaviour

Should children not follow the school expectations for behaviour, compromising the health and safety of others, after an initial warning (straight face), a further warning (sad face), a member of SLT will supervise the child (socially distanced), in calm reflection time and away from the bubble area and parents will be informed.

If a child spits, or coughs at another person or continues not to follow safety rules, then the child will be immediately isolated with a member of SLT. Through discussions, we will establish whether this is accidental or deliberate and the parent will be telephoned to ensure the safety of all. A risk assessment will then be undertaken to determine whether the safety of the child and others is possible to achieve with the child remaining in school. The school will also consult Hamwic Education Trust for behaviour support (see below for Government guidance on exclusions).

Exclusions from maintained schools, academies and pupil referral units in England continue to follow the guidance from 2017.

Individual Needs and Behaviour Plans

Individual behaviour plans that are in place, will be updated and regularly reviewed to ensure the child is supported in following the behaviour expectations. Where a child requires ELSA support, this will be provided with the adult and child sat socially distanced in a one-to-one session.

Schools Trips

There will be no school trips during the first half term of the new school year..

Physical intervention

On the rare occasion when trained staff may need to use restrictive physical intervention or positive handling, they will use PPE (gloves, apron, mask and a visor if a child is spitting). See Physical Intervention Policy.
