LD (IV) identifies four A concepts/words that will thread through the whole curriculum to enable continuity across the key stages: ***community, belonging, love and special.***

In Year R, at least one of these *golden thread* concepts/words should be introduced. In Year 1, children will study two of the *golden thread* concepts/words and in Year 2 the other two.

Golden thread concepts/words will be highlighted in red and italics.

Ideas for potential learning opportunities are added in purple and italics.
